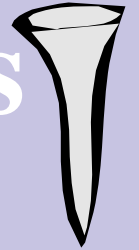

## ENTER BY JUNE 1<sup>ST</sup>

The JGA was established in 1987 with the purpose of providing quality golf experiences for area juniors at affordable rates. Continuing with this tradition leads to another expanded schedule of events for 2007. The nominal \$40.00 entry fee if entered by June 1<sup>st</sup> makes the JGA the best value for junior golf in the area. A \$10.00 late fee applies for entries received after June 1<sup>st</sup>. The entry fee is all-inclusive for the 10 & Under and the 11-12 age divisions. For the 13-14 and 15-17 age groups, the entry fee includes up to 4 events with a \$5.00 fee for each additional event. Please read and fill out the entry form carefully. There will be no refunds for any reason except in the 15-17 age group where the tournament field size may be limited.

Be sure to sign up for the JGA Father-Son / Parent-Child event to be held on Sunday, August 5<sup>th</sup> at Eastern Hills. Entries will be available online in July.

# AGE GROUP DESCRIPTIONS

## 10 & Under

This division meets nine times throughout the summer. The first four weeks will be on the driving range at Grand Prairie Golf Course. These sessions will concentrate on rules, etiquette and instruction about the golf swing. Grand Prairie has a fine teaching facility where we will be able to hit practice balls, practice our short game and fine-tune our putting. The next four events will be playing at Red Arrow Golf Club. The 8 and under group will play three holes while the 9-10 year olds will play six holes. We would like to have at least one adult walk with each group. Parent volunteers are an important part of the success of this program. The final event is the 12 & Under Championship at Grand Prairie where our goal is to have all participants play 9 holes.



## 13 & 14

This age division is designed to prepare for high school competition. The events will have a tournament flavor and will enable the player to feel what it is like to play at the higher levels. In this division both boys and girls will play 18 holes. We encourage parents to volunteer to help administer the tournament.

## 15 - 17

This age division is designed to allow the high-school aged player to compete in events throughout the summer that will be similar to their school events. The eight events are held at some of the area's finest courses. The tournaments are governed by the USGA Rules of Golf and all results are sent to high school coaches. Many coaches use these tournaments as a barometer of the progress of their players throughout the summer. The season-ending 36-hole championship is just before the school season starts, which gives the JGA player a head start on the competition. Both boys and girls will play 18 holes in this division. **Field size may be limited in this age group, so sign up early!**

## 11 & 12

Players in this division are expected to be able to play under the USGA rules of golf, keep score on the golf course, and total and sign their scorecard at the end of each round. These events will be treated as formal tournaments, which will give many participants their first competitive experience. The tournament schedule includes seven 9 hole events at some of the area's shorter courses. This year we will be playing Red Arrow, Maple Hills, Hickory Ridge, Grand Prairie, Eastern Hills West and the short course at Kalamazoo Country Club. We want to have an adult walk with each of these groups so please try to arrange your time to help during at least one event.



## JOHN BLOCK JGA SCHOLARSHIP WINNERS

Each year, graduating seniors compete for one of the two \$1,500 JGA scholarships that will be awarded directly to the college or university of their choice. It takes more than just a sound golf game to be eligible for the scholarships. Awards are based on prior participation in the JGA, academics (cumulative 2.5 GPA) and displaying good character and citizenship both on and off the golf course. An application is enclosed with this newsletter and must be submitted by June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007 to be considered. # FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS...



**Q Why are there additional event fees? Can I get a refund if I don't play in an event?**

**A** The JGA strives to maintain the best possible value for junior golfers. The expansion of the schedule means rising costs. Signing up early helps us better plan these events. The \$10.00 late registration fee and the \$5.00 fee for additional events in the 13-14 and 15-17 age group help us to cover costs while keeping the pricing fair, especially for those who only play in a few events. There are no refunds for any reason unless the tournament field size is limited. You are allowed to add or change events during the season if space permits.

**Q Is there a penalty for not showing up for an event I have signed up for?**

**A** Yes. According to the JGA Code of Conduct, failure to show up for an event you are scheduled for may result in a suspension from the next entered JGA event. Remember that you are paired with 2-3 other players. Not giving us ample notice of a cancellation may affect the pairings and/or tee times of those other players. It is also discourteous to the host courses that have planned for a certain number of players. In order to maintain the integrity and stature of the JGA, we ask that you only sign up for the events you are certain you can attend. Poor attendance may affect the costs and ability of the JGA to find quality courses in the future to host our events. **Q My child is over 10 years old but has never played golf before. Can he or she still participate in the JGA?**

**A** Yes. However, some sort of formal instruction is recommended, as tournament play is all that is offered for the older age groups. Formal instruction from local PGA professionals is available at reasonable rates. A schedule for many of the programs offered at area courses is included with this newsletter. **Q Can I request tee times?**

**A** No. In order to maintain a tournament flavor to the AJGA, there will be no tee time requests. We understand that there may be transportation concerns for some parents, but handling 400+ tee time requests is impracticable for our administrative volunteers. Please be aware that it is your responsibility to verify your tee time and let us know if you will be unable to participate. Remember that most tee times are normally between 8:00am and 11:00am and plan your schedule accordingly.

**Q When will tee times be available? How do I get directions to the courses?**

**A** Tee times will be available via our website ([www.kalamazoogolf.org](http://www.kalamazoogolf.org)) approximately one week before each event. No notices will be mailed out. It is each player's responsibility to arrive at his or her tee time 15 minutes early. Directions are available by calling each golf course directly.

**Q Can my child move up an age division? Can my child participate in two different age divisions?**

**A** Each child may only play in one age division. We do not encourage moving up an age division, but if this option is taken, that will be the only division in which your child may participate.

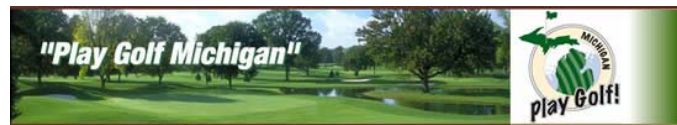

# JUNIOR GOLF EQUIPMENT

**W**hy buy junior clubs? Why can't I just cut down an old set of clubs? These are the usual questions we hear from parents. Cutting down adult clubs is a common practice and is acceptable when price or availability hinder the use of proper equipment, but remember that junior golf clubs are *designed* for the junior golfer. A cut-down club will be too heavy and too stiff for optimal performance, plus, the grip usually won't fit on the shaft properly. Junior clubs are lighter, balanced properly, have more flex in the shaft and have the proper size grips. Using golf equipment that doesn't fit properly as a junior can cause poor swing habits that will haunt a golfer for the rest of his or her life.

**M**ost junior sets can be purchased according to age and/or height, with prices varying based on quality and number of clubs in the set. A common configuration for a junior set is to have 1 wood, 2 irons, a putter and a bag. The wood is usually a lofted one such as a 3 wood or 5 wood. The irons are usually a mid lofted (5 or 7 iron) and a higher lofted (9 iron or wedge). This type of set is considered to be the minimum necessary to participate in golf.

# JGA CODE OF CONDUCT

## 1. TOURNAMENT CANCELLATIONS, NO SHOWS, AND WITHDRAWALS

The largest single problem facing the JGA relating to tournament administration is the failure of junior golfers to meet their scheduled tee times. The result is confusion at tournaments and causes considerable embarrassment to the association in its important relationship with the local golf course professional. The following policy has been adopted by the JGA to impress upon the junior golfers their responsibility to the association:

*Any participant who fails to give 48 hour prior notice of cancellation, does not show up for an event, withdraws from an event without notice or does not return a scorecard for an event may be suspended from the next entered JGA tournament. A second violation in a season may result in suspension from all remaining tournaments without refund. If the violation falls on the last tournament of the season, the suspension will carry over to the following year.*

## 2. TOURNAMENT CONFIRMATION AND TEE TIMES

The JGA does NOT confirm acceptance in the association nor tee times for an event by mail or by phone (we do not call you). You may find all tee times and registration lists on the JGA website at [www.kalamazoogolf.org](http://www.kalamazoogolf.org). The official tee sheet for each event will be located at Grand Prairie G. C. until the day of the event, in which case it will be at the host site. The JGA reserves the right to adjust your tee time by 10 minutes without notice, and with notification if more than 10 minutes.

## 3. CHECK-IN PROCEDURE AND INCLEMENT WEATHER

Participants must check in at the starter's table to confirm tee time and receive scorecard **15 minutes before his or her scheduled tee time**. The USGA Rule 6-3 concerning disqualification may be enforced for late arrivals. In the event of inclement weather, a decision to hold or cancel the event will be made as soon as possible (usually by the first scheduled tee time) on the morning of the event. Tee times may be delayed up to 1 hour, but the event will be canceled if play cannot be started within 1 hour. You are still expected to arrive for your scheduled tee time even if the weather looks bad - it may not be bad at the tournament site. Play will be immediately discontinued whenever there is lightning present.

## 4. PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT, CADDIES, PACE OF PLAY

The JGA highly encourages parents to participate in their child's progress with the game of golf. However, the JGA prohibits the use of caddies for all participants, except in the 10 & under age group, where parents may act as caddies. Parents are encouraged to help with pace of play and finding lost balls, but shall defer all rulings to the JGA staff. **Parents and spectators are not allowed to give advice** except in the 10 & under age group. (Please see USGA Rule 8-1 regarding the 2-stroke penalty for advice.) Pace of Play will be monitored and appropriate penalties assessed when necessary.

## 5. DRESS CODE

Proper golf attire is required at all times. Collared shirts may be required at certain facilities. Shirts may be required to be tucked in at certain facilities. Denim jeans or denim shorts, tank tops, cut-offs and clothing considered offensive is prohibited. Hats must be worn with bill forward at all times. Shoes with metal spikes are prohibited. Penalty for breach of dress code will be immediate disqualification.

## 6. SPECIFIC CODE OF CONDUCT VIOLATIONS INCLUDE:

- Lack of respect to the scorer, tournament officials or another player.
- Failure to abide by the Rules of Golf or a decision by an official.
- Damage to green and/or other course property.
- Throwing clubs.
- Obscene or vulgar language.
- Use of tobacco, alcohol or drugs (unless medically prescribed) during play.
- Any other conduct or behavior deemed to be improper.

## 7. CODE OF CONDUCT VIOLATION PENALTIES:

Upon any violation of the Code of Conduct, a player may receive any or all of the following: **a verbal and/or written warning; a two-stroke penalty; immediate disqualification; suspension of membership without refund**. All Code of Conduct penalties will be decided between the JGA and the players involved.
